

Instructions for filing Affidavit of Heirship

Fill out the Affidavit of Heirship Form completely.

Have the Affidavit executed before a Notary Public. Please note that this Affidavit must be attested to and executed by the Executor of the Estate or an **uninterested third party**, namely someone who is not a beneficiary of this estate.

Send the Affidavit to be recorded in the County/State where the **minerals** are located. You will need to include a check to cover the applicable recording fees. Fees for most counties in Kansas are \$21 for the first page and \$17 for each additional page.

You will also need to include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of your document.
